<u>New Zealand Made Day</u> is a celebration of New Zealand Made that falls on **21st November** every year. Established in 2019, hundreds of businesses across Aotearoa New Zealand get involved to share their NZ Made products, services, and the stories behind them. Kiwis are encouraged to get behind their favorite Kiwi business and support local in the lead-up to Christmas.

WHY GET INVOLVED

NZ Made Day is a chance for Kiwis to discover NZ Made products and for NZ Made brands to be seen and supported by shoppers. Kiwis love to support local businesses:

- 87% of Kiwis often consider whether a product is NZ Made
- 86% of Kiwis are willing to pay a premium for NZ Made

NZ Made Day generates a vast amount of content, engagements, and conversations on social media. NZ Made Day is also covered by mainstream media. In 2022 and 2023, it was featured on TVNZ's Seven Sharp, as well as other notable media publications. Small businesses have recorded a 10x sales increase across the day.
